

## Call for Consorts Choralfest® 2019

Following feedback, the Choralfest committee has decided to extend the deadline for the call for Consorts to **2 November 2018** and also offer an updated pricing structure. A Consort Fee of \$130 per consort member will apply to successful consorts. This fee includes participation in the Consorts stream only and does not include Choralfest registration. Please read below for further information.

A special feature of Choralfest 2019 will be a stream aimed at vocal consorts. Consorts should be unconducted ensembles of between four and eight members. They may be female, male or mixed, and present repertoire of any kind. They will be given opportunities to take part in dedicated Consort classes with Robert Hollingworth, and to participate in other performance and teaching sessions, as well as attending and performing in Choralfest concerts.

Robert Hollingworth has an international reputation for his performance of Medieval, Renaissance and Twentieth Century music as well as projects that blend styles and media. Consorts considering applying may find it useful to view the many videos of his group *I Fagiolini* online, as well as visiting his websites:

Consorts should apply providing the following information and resources:

1. Name and voice part of each member
2. A brief statement about the group (e.g. name of the ensemble; previous experience of singing together)
3. Designated member with whom contact should be made, including their full details (name; Address; Telephone number; email; institutional affiliation)
4. Proposal of three pieces of repertoire the consort would anticipate performing at *Choralfest*
5. If possible: an mp3 file of a performance

### Key Information

- Closing Date for consort applications: 2 November 2018
- Consorts will be notified by: End November 2018
- Final Repertoire selections to be submitted for committee approval by: 1 February 2018 (to include full details of repertoire to be performed, including duration, composer/arranger and publisher.
- On selection consorts will be asked to provide program information for the conference handbook and concert programs.
- A Consort Fee of \$130 per consort member will apply to successful consorts. This fee includes participation in the Consorts stream only and does not include Choralfest registration.
